- 7. District and County Councillor Reports County Cllr Stevens reported:

WCC has recently agreed it's five-year plan and budget for 2020 – 2021. WCC is still awaiting information from the Government regarding the future policy of local government funding, devolution and Adult Health and social security. Full details of WCC budget can be found on WCC's website. The recent exceptional weather has highlighted the issues with flooding, particularly within the south of the county. WCC are actively bidding for assistance from the Environment Agency. In the meantime WCC has put more funding into the jetting and clearing of highway drainage. HS2 has been given the final go-ahead and there will be an increase in road closures and lorry movements. Currently there are no cases of Corona Virus in Warwickshire. Community Grants are now available for Community Groups. There is also a highway fund for minor improvements.

# **District Cllr Rock reported:**

The District Council determined its budget on 24 February resulting in an increase in Council Tax of 3.59%. For a band D property this means that the District Council element rises from £139.12 to £144.12. Because Stratford also collects the council tax for Warwickshire Council (3.99% increase), the Police Commissioner 4.38% increase, these were reported as well. By the time these are added up the band D tax comes to £1870.99 to be paid annually. A proposal to defer and review the introduction of green waste charges was voted down by the ruling administration. HS2 - HS2 contractor Eiffage Kier are presently trailing a system to track vehicles.

# 10.2 Flooding and drainage

Following the recent heavy rain the flood barriers have been used twice, no houses were flooded. There was some flooding at Ladbroke Hall. WCC Gully sucker machines have been up and down the village.

A photo of the flooding near Church Cottage has been sent to the Locality Officer for information.

The drain at the end of Garden Cottage is regularly blocked by silt from Bettys Farm – Clerk to report to Locality Officer.

#### 10.3 Village Hall and Millennium Green

The Parish Council offered their congratulations on the new Village Hall entrance. The Village Hall Committee are now looking to do the kitchen and the toilet roof at the rear of the hall.

Millenium Green are applying for a grant from Severn Trent.

#### 10.4 Broadband

All open areas around Ladbroke are due to be provided with Broadband this summer.

#### 10.5 HS2

Currently are undertaking trial archaeological trenches at Windmill Lane.

The cable for the tunnel boring machine is coming from Italy. It was due to come by rail but is now coming by ship. There will be a four week delay, this will delay the cable pulling and jointing.

The tunnel boring machine has been ordered from Germany.

Greenwood Nurseries is due to close at the end of March 2020.

The overbridge on the A423 is scheduled to start in 2021.
